The members of the West Coast Reining Horse Association walked away with a HUGE number of wins at the 2013 Reining By The Bay show held this year on July 17th through the 21st in Woodside, California. A significant number of the big-money aged events were won by WCRHA members.

Gabe Davide won the Level 4 and 3 Open Derby Champion on OK Spook owned by Stacey Snow in a very exciting and close race. Mike Boyle was Level 2 Derby Champion on Easy Lil Lady owned by the Darling 888 Ranch.

It was a great weekend for WCRHA Non-Pro rider Cam Essick who took the Level 4 and 3 Non-Pro Futurity Cham-

pion on her beautiful horse, Holier Then Thou. Cam also was Reserve Champion in the top 3 levels of the Non-Pro Derby and won the Prime Time Non-Pro Derby riding Who Loves You. Great job, Cam!

There were a large number of other WCRHA members bringing home big checks from these events. See the RBB website for the full set of results.

Other big winners in the aged events were: Level 4 Open Futurity Champion, Martin Muehlstaetter on Chexmart. Jackson Porath was the Intermediate Open Futurity

Participants learned many of the thought processes behind those sitting in the judge's chair and had a chance to judge maneuvers themselves.

Our Rookie Day in April was the biggest to date and may have been the biggest in the country.

The "Rein For the Roses" affiliate #2 qualifier show lived up to its reputation as being very exciting, combining the KY Derby with its own Derby on the Derby, parties and hat parade. We were especially fortunate to have Inside Reining there to televise our events on RFDTV and to showcase some of our professionals in their training segments. If you have not seen it yet, you can go to the Inside Reining website and view past episodes. This was great national exposure for the WCRHA.

Affiliates #3 & #4, featuring our biggest ever NP Shootout, saw winners going home with many prizes, including cash in hand! That week saw over 200 competitors, making it one of our largest shows.

This year the WCRHA had our first ever booth representation at the California Horse Expo in June. The booth helped introduce reining to folks from all over California and Nevada.

The fireworks really got going at the Affiliates #5 & #6, which was held over the hot Fourth of July weekend. There were so many activities at that show including potluck, dog races, trainer races, youth horse wash fundraiser and a fireworks display.

Later in July we saw one of the premier NRHA events come into our area, The Reining By The Bay. We have now formed a sponsorship alliance with Brumley Management Group LLC and look forward to our partnership with them and their 3 shows including the Cactus Classic, The High Roller Reining Classic and The Reining By The Bay. World recognized riders came from all over the West to compete at this premier event and our WCRHA members really showcased their riding abilities and horsepower, winning the Non-Pro Futurity and the Open Derby! 
The Little Red Horse

Any truly engaging success story does not begin, finish and end in a clean succinct straight line. A truly captivating story has an Under Dog, a struggle, uncertainty, a few dead ends, and ultimately a denouement that makes us happy that we read to the end of the story. The story must include moments of nauseating uncertainty so that we can relish in the joy that comes on the heels of failure or disappointment. Ultimately, despite the unexpected curve ball thrown our way, we want the story to end in a raucous thunder of applause. And so this story will go.....

He had been passed out of the NRCHA Select Two Year Old Sale because he hadn't brought enough money. Why should he?

He was a cute Little Red Horse, without much to "set him apart." He was bred well enough, but he was green, hadn't entirely filled out physically and had a propensity to crib. Besides everything else, he was not NRBC nominated which would hurt his value.

Disappointed, OK Spook's owners loaded him up and brought him back to the valley where they put him in training with Brad Buttery. Through the grapevine, this is where Gabe Davide and Stacie Snow found "Spook." Shopping on a little bit of a budget, the pair knew that they would have to make some concessions in their purchase, and knowing that their goal set did not include purchasing a Futurity horse, they weighed the pros and cons, overlooked the stud colt's imperfections, and decided that they liked the way he rode well enough to take him home and give him a shot. It was no secret that the colt was green, but Gabe enjoyed him anyway. The raw talent was there, the disposition was there, and the connection between horse and rider seemed to be a match. So, with the full support of Spook's new owner Stacie, Gabe began the slow steady process of building a long term show horse. First and foremost, he started hauling him to all the shows so that all of the appropriate miles could be logged and the maturing process could take place. After a week at Reining By The Bay, it was decided that Spook might make a better gelding. With a little break under his belt, Spook then went to Las Vegas, and even though he wasn't necessarily slated to be a Futurity




feeling like he was riding well, Stacie and Gabe agreed to enter him. The Little Red Horse proved he had The Try that they

had hoped for. The pair left Sin City with 220.5, taking home to Gilroy the Intermediate and Limited Open Reserve Championship Titles.

As a four year old, Spook's story becomes a little more tenuous. A 215 at Cactus Classic and a disappointing 214 after the long expensive trip to the Derby in Oklahoma City, Gabe and Stacie remained steadfast in their resolve that they had a great horse. Undaunted, Stacie gave Gabe free rein to do "whatever he thought was best for Spook." She knew the horse had it in him, she had faith in Gabe's vision, and she remained loyal to the big picture. A few months later, Spook would thank them for their faith in him by offering up a 225 at Reining By The Bay, placing Reserve in both the Intermediate Open and Limited Open Derbies.

With the onset of his five year old year, the pair would start the season strong, marking a 223.5 at the Cactus Classic. Confi-





dent in his horse, Gabe headed back to OKC again to make a run at NRHA Derby money, which once again proved to be elusive. Undeterred by the disappointment of the Derby, Gabe, Stacie, and Spook returned home, regrouped and left a 223.5 in the sand of one of the toughest arenas on the West Coast at Reining By The Bay. Vegas was soon to follow where the duo marked a 227 and were Open Derby Reserve Champions and Intermediate

Open Champions adding even more winnings to Spook's rapidly growing LTE.

With the success and scores and earnings, interest in Spook as an FEI horse picked up, but even after marking a 219 at The NRHA Open Shootout in November, nobody could quite bring themselves to commit to the merits of The Little Red Horse.

Winter came and went and an abscess sidelined Spook for the spring. A little rest and relaxation must have been just the ticket, because as luck would have it,

Spook was fixing to tie one on that would drive the crowds crazy and elevate Gabe to Super Hero. Back in the white sand where Spook had shown so well in the past, he put together a run for the record books. Flawless in every maneuver, The Little Red Horse would put his heart into every step he took, and when the dust settled and the tracks lay long in front of the judge's stand, Spook and Gabe would be RBB Open Derby Champions with

a score of 232! And so it goes...an Under Dog, a vision, a commitment. Disappointment, tenacity, and desire. A grocery list of attributes that build the ultimate story of victory.....enter raucous applause!!!

# Holey Moley! Look Who "Cam" to Play!

Perseverance and patience has paid off for Cam Essick of Pacific Range Ranch, owned by Cam and her husband, Jim. The results of Cam's horse breeding opera-

tion left their mark at the 2013 Reining By The Bay show held July 17-21 at the beautiful Horse Park in Woodside, California. Cam has based her breeding operation on mares that she successfully showed years ago. In fact, three full sisters that Cam showed "back in the day" (Smart Little Lena x Slide Me Again) produced winning offspring at this prestigious reining event put on by Brumley Management Group. Those mares

are Slylena, Love Em N Lena, and She Slides Wright.

On Friday of the show, Cam started the morning out by showing her 3 year old gelding, Holier Then Thou (Jacs Electric Spark x

Slylena) in the Smartpak Non Pro Futurity. With a score of 213, Cam came out on top in both the Non Pro and Intermediate Non Pro levels.

As if this wasn't exciting enough, Cam came back later that afternoon to show in the \$35,000-added Bob's Custom Saddles Non Pro Derby, this time aboard Love Em N Lena's produce, Who Loves You, a 4 year old gelding. With a score of 220, Cam and Who Loves You were the Prime Time Non Pro Champions and Reserve Champions in the Non Pro Level 4, Intermediate Non Pro Level 3 and Limited Non Pro Level 2 classes.

Lastly, Cash Only No Chex, a very stylish sorrel stallion by Big Chex To Cash out of She Slides Wright, who was purchased by Andrea and Tish Fappani, tied for the Reserve Championship in the Open Futurity.

Cam is also proud of Ashley Severson's Intuitshine, a pretty palomino gelding she purchased as a long yearling from Pacific Range Ranch. Intuitshine was the Reserve Champion of the Non Pro Derby Level 1 and was also third High Point Horse in the Limited Non Pro of the ancillary classes.

In her breeding operation, Cam raises six to eight foals each year with the intent of selling them as Open competitors. "If they don't sell," she says, "then I ride them and show them." Cam returned home with six buckles, a multitude of other prizes, and winnings of over \$13,000. Holey Moley! It can't get much better than this!



### WARM UP PEN ETIQUETTE

- 1. Be aware of everything that is happening around you. The warm up pen is not the time to look at the ground or be on your cell phones. If you must take a call or text, please leave the arena or stand somewhere safe, away from moving horses. Keep your eyes up and pay attention.
- 2. When the water truck enters the arena, please leave the
- 3. When tractor enters the arena, all loping should stop. Please move out of the way of the tractor, either leaving the arena or moving to sides where he is not working.
- 4. Take a minute to check which way people are circling. One side of the arena is for left circles, one side is for right circles. Do not lope in the opposite direction of the flow as this can be very confusing and cause an accident.
- 5. Be very aware when schooling stops in the middle of the circles, riders may consider stopping off center to allow other horses to come through the middle. Do not linger in the middle.
- 6. Spin in the center of the circles that are being run but not on the path of the circle. Watch for people who are fencing.
- 7. Stay off the rail if folks are circling. Circlers have the right of way. Slower horses (walk/trot included) should stay on the inside of the circles and be in single file
- 8. Look around before you stop and back your horse. Make certain that no one is immediately following in your path.
- 9. When folks line up against the short wall, it's fencing time. If your pen is not being time controlled, ( half hour fencing, half hour circling) please be careful and watch for riders running up and down the arena. If the arena is time controlled, please follow direction from the arena monitor and circle or fence according to their direction.
- 10. If there is any chance someone might be in your way or not paying attention, please give them a "heads up" to avoid and accident. Again, circlers have the right of way when the pen is not being time controlled.
- 11. It is best not to sit in the middle of the arena when people are fencing.
- 12. If you are resting or grooming while fencing is going on, don't stay in the middle of the wall to rest, go towards the outside of the wall to keep the middle of the area open for fencing horses.
- 13. If there are too many horses in the warm up pen and it is creating a dangerous environment, the WCRHA will ask that only those whose draw is coming up in the working order (in a reasonable amount of time) remain in the warm up.
- 14. If you are riding a colt or exercising a horse not preparing for show and the show is still running, please find an alternate arena to ride.






