Gold and Grand has been revised so every show will count towards our WCRHA Year End Awards Points. Also Green As Grass rules have been revised to better


serve our very important grass roots riders. Make sure to check out the rules on our website.

Change in Eligibility for WCRHA Green as Grass Class Starting in 2017!!

To meet the needs of our new WCRHA members just starting out in reining who may have shown one time years ago or joined WCRHA in the middle of the year and want to show a reiner without losing their chance at a full year of the WCRHA Green As Grass class, the WCRHA Board of Directors has changed the eligibility for the WCRHA Green As Grass Class starting in 2017.

WCRHA GREEN AS GRASS *NOT NRHA APPROVED - ***NEW for 2017***for Non Pro, Youth and Amateur riders in their FIRST OR SECOND YEAR ONLY of showing reiners. If you have shown a Reiner at any show whatsoever at any time that counts as one year of showing. You will not be eligible for a second year of showing in Green As Grass if (1) You win the WCRHA Year End High Point Champion or Reserve Champion Award in Green As Grass or any other class, or (2) You have more than \$50 in lifetime reining earnings (from any and all shows, NOT limited to NRHA earnings). Green As Grass riders may use two hands with any legal bit, and may ride a horse owned by someone else (including non-famiy members). Not Jackpotted (no prize money paid out) – ribbons or awards only.

I Love Ya \$100,000 Highest Selling Horse at the 2016 NRHA Futurity

The last of three NRHA Futurity Sales was the 2016 NRHA/Markel Select Yearling Sale which offered 81 highly scrutinized consignments. Each boasted the promise of a bright future, backed by generations

of bold type performers and producers. The bidding started briskly on several colts, but the high seller ultimately proved to be a stellar bred filly named I Love Ya. When the bay mare walked through the ring as Hip #3055, high activity from the floor ensued with a final winning bid of \$100,000 being placed by Coguaike, LLC. Consigned by her breeder Cam Essick of California, I Love Ya is by Gunnatrashya and out of Cam's great mare Love Em N Lena (Smart Little Lena x Slide Me Again), a mare with \$114,191 in NRHA and NRCHA earnings. With that pedigree, I Love Ya is a full sister to 2016 NRHA Open L4 and L3 Futurity Finalist and Open L2 NRHA Futurity Reserve Champion, Loveya, a colt also bred and

and out of Slide Me Again (PE: \$260,518) which also produced the 1994 NRHA Open Futurity Champion, Lenas Wright On. Essick said I Love Ya reminds her a lot of her dam, Love Em N Lena.


owned by Essick that earned \$76,294 in his futurity season with rider Fernando Salgado.

Cam and her husband Jim "Too Tall" Essick, own and operate Pacific Range Ranch in Clements, California. Breeding a select group of around 8 broodmares, their program is anchored by three full sisters—Love Em N Lena (NRCHA and NRHA LTE: \$114,191, PE: \$240,927), Slylena (LTE: \$8,540, PE: \$192,631), and She Slides Wright (LTE: \$3,319, PE: \$136,746), all sired by leading sire and performer Smart Little Lena

"They have all been serious, working horses; they don't have attitudes, they don't need a lot of attention, and they're very quick to learn. Her dam was just a straightup athlete," Cam noted. "During the sale I had a lot of people that wanted me to price her before she went through the ring, but I work in this industry and I always want to be good for my word and credible. So I felt it was important to have her run through the sale." As the owner of Pacific Range Design Group, Cam is well known throughout the performance horse industry thanks to her talented photographic, graphic, and marketing skills. A leading non pro rider,

Essick has NRHA earnings of over \$117,000, and did the fitting herself on her consignments in the Select Sale. Her other consignment, Gunna Slide Me Again (Gunnatrashya x Slylena) was purchased for \$22,000 by Heather Ruthven. "My goal is to always breed a Level 4 Open horse. As a non pro, that's what I have to ride. Because I ride by myself after work with no instruction, I have to at least have that athletic ability underneath me," she said. Due to the time constraints of her job, Essick added, she doesn't have the opportunity to ride


with a professional on a regular basis. "I choose to have my job first, but I also take my breeding program and riding seriously because I basically show for dollars. I can't go to a show unless I feel fairly confident that I am going to get a check. I love the industry and I love the challenge of it, but I take it very seriously. Sometimes I do wish it was more of a hobby for me." In 2015 Cam bred the L4 Non Pro Futurity Champion and was #12 breeder of Reining Horses worldwide. In 2016 she finishes up #14 as an owner and is also a leading breeder of Reining Horses. Her mare Love Em N Lena is now the dam of four yearlings that have received High Selling honors and four offspring to make the L4 Open finals in NRHA and NRCHA Futurities. 1/2









Gotta Twist It Up at the 2016 Oklahoma NRHA Futurity Finals

One of our very own members had fantastic success out at the 2016 Oklahoma NRHA Futurity Finals. Sandra Bentien and "Gotta Twist It Up", better known as "Ace", scored a 215 with a beautiful run that earned them the titles of Level 2 and Level 3 futurity champions, as well as fourth in Level 4, winning \$62,737. For Sandra to have so much success her first time showing in the futurity finals is incredible, especially considering the fact she put on most of the stud colt's training. Gotta Twist It Up is out of Spooks Gotta Whiz and Sandra's own successful

mare, Make It With A Twist. Sandra tore her ACL completely a couple years back, and knowing that she could not even swing a leg over a horse without a mounting block, she sent Ace out for a couple months to Jenny Sherbo to get him broke. Jenny rode him out with cattle and just let Ace learn the basics without teaching reining maneuvers. Sandra is a big advocate for starting babies with the intent of getting them broke before teaching them how to perform. Ace even got a little bit of time with Mark Harnden. who helped in bringing about Ace's best feature, his stop. The rest was all Sandra's patience, dedication, and passion for the sport shining through. From the ground up (or perhaps I should say by the embryo up), this horse was her own handi-

work. With a couple weeks of coaching from Casey Deary leading up to and during Oklahoma, Sandra continued staying humble and setting herself up for success. Going to the futurity and not only making it to the finals, but winning some championships, was a dream come true for her. Gotta Twist It Up's LTE are now \$67,000+, and Sandra and her friends and family are excited to see where this talented horse will go from here.

Sandra dedicated her futurity final ride to her dad who had brought home her first pony at the age five. He surely had no clue what he had started by encouraging his daughter's love for horses, but he was always her biggest cheerleader, and she knows how proud he must be up above.
