While all volunteers are vital to the smooth operation of a show, I want to take this opportunity to highlight a few members and their jobs that they perform before, during and after a show.



pated in the morning clinic and afternoon show.

For those of you who are not familiar with the National Reining Horse Association's Rookie Day, it serves two purposes. 1. It is a program within the Reining Horse Sports Foundation (RHSF) that is a unique opportunity for newer/ beginning reiners to receive training from local professionals combined with an actual class all in an effort to help newer/ beginner reiners prepare for the show pen. Riders will be critiqued and educated on how they were scored and have an opportunity to win some pretty cool prizes, including buckles! 2. Most importantly though all the funds from this event go to help support the RHSF Crisis Fund and NRHA members in their time of need.

The morning started out with a brief meeting between the professionals and the student riders to draw names out of a cowboy hat to determine which riders would be with which professionals. They then divided up into groups and went to the arenas to start the clinic.

The clinic lasted for three hours where the professionals helped their student riders with all the reining maneuvers. And, if they needed a little extra help on a particular maneuver, they then spent additional time on that particular maneuver.

After lunch, all the students then needed to get into their show clothes and back numbers placed on their show saddle blankets. One thing about Rookie Day is that there is an actual show in the afternoon in front of a NRHA carded judge. The exhibitors are judged in accordance with the NRHA rules and scores are awarded in accordance with the rules.

It was obvious that everyone tried their very best during the show. When the show was all said and done, the results were as follows:

Champion: Mark Faley riding Chrome Starlight with a score of 72.

Reserve Champion: Loren Braucht riding lean With Midnight with a score of 69.

Third place: Cathy James riding Gallos Creed with a score of 68.5

There was a tie for fourth place between Willow Newcomb riding Lil Annie Quiotie and Olivia Grupp riding Scooter Zippin Legacy. Both had a score of 68.

Youth Champion went to Carly Ball riding Que Paza Dreams.

All exhibitors did an excellent job. I heard many remarks that they received a lot of knowledge and experience out of the clinic and show.

I was the coordinator of Rookie Day again this year but I could not have done without the help of many people. A huge


Did you know? Kelli Brummett and the horse show committee spend many hours working on the schedule and putting together the premium so that the show days go as smoothly as possible.


Did you know? During the hours of 7 am to 6 pm, arena lights at MEC cost \$100.00 per day, but if we go over hours, it is an additional \$125.00 per hour. At Affiliate #1, we had 20 hours of "after hours lights" as a courtesy to our exhibitors, for a total of \$2,500.00 in added expenses.

Did you know? We pay MEC staff overtime, just like the lights. At Affiliate #1, we had 22 hours of staff overtime for an additional cost of \$660.00. So when you are tired at the end of a long show day, remember to thank the MEC staff because they have to be there late also.

The Board reviews each horse show and the expenses involved in putting on the excellent shows of which we are accustomed. It is always our goal to keep entry fees and stabling fees as affordable as possible for our members. 



WCRHA IS Awarded \$1,500 FROM NRHA

West Coast Reining Horse Association is 1 of 72 Affiliates of the NRHA in the United States. In 2013 the NRHA offered an Affiliate Incentive Program to encourage Affiliates to hold educational, fundraising and developmental programs.

WCRHA achieved the Gold Level which is the highest level of the program and was awarded \$1500 from NRHA. Only 4 of the 72 Affiliates achieved the Gold Level and WCRHA was 1 of the 4 according to Shianne Megel who is the Director of Events and Affiliates for NRHA.

In order to accomplish this, WCRHA had to complete a defined number of programs within a year.

At the start of the year an Affiliate Application and Agreement, a Circuit of Shows Application, WCRHA Bylaws and Dues must be submitted to NRHA.


WCRHA must then designate an Affiliate Liaison who must participate in an NRHA webinar regarding knowledge of Affiliates and Affiliate Shows, must attend the Regional Summit at the Regional Affiliate Finals and must attend the Affiliate Summit at either the NRHA Derby or Futurity. Kelli Brummett is the Affiliate Liaison for WCRHA and attended all of the required events on behalf of WCRHA.


WCRHA must hold at least one Affiliate show and offer NRHA Green Levels 1 & 2 classes at two separate shows and Entry Level Ride & Slide classes at one show. WCRHA held five Affiliate shows and offered the required classes at every Affiliate show.

WCRHA held a Rookie Day event and a Membership Secrets of Judging Course which are developmental programs successfully organized for WCRHA members and others interested in reining by Mike Silva.






