WCRHA YEAR END AWARD WINNERS



Every year, members vie for championship honors at the year's end by competing in a minimum of four WCRHA approved shows (with the exception of three shows for the Short Stirrup riders). In addition to the five NRHA approved affiliate shows, points are also earned at the Spring and Summer Gold-N-Grand shows held at the Murieta Equestrian Center as well as the CSHA approved shows held at the Rolling Hills Equestrian Center in Corning. Ties in point totals are broken by monies earned. More complete details of the points can be found online at www.wcrha.com. Thank you to board member, Rachel Fingerle, for dutifully tabulating these points all year!

Awards are formally presented at the Awards Banquet to be held January 18, 2020, at the Murieta Inn and Spa. Champions and Reserve Champions will receive beautiful buckles. Other nice awards are given out to third through fifth place finishers. All places receive handsome, embroidered award jackets for their year-long efforts.

"She did it all, from sending entries to working with clients and helping find good horses and making their local affiliate run," Brown shared. "There was not one part of this business that she didn't have her hand in, one way of another."

In naming this award in her honor, the Professionals Committee hopes she will serve as a continuous reminder about what it means to be named Horsewoman of the Year.

"She's been an inspiration to people in this industry at all levels," said Patrick Flaherty, NRHA Professionals Committee Chair. "She's a huge influence, and I strongly believe her affiliate is successful today because of what she put into it. She and David set up an incredible business because of how they complemented each other. Their sup-

port was pivotal to their business and our industry."

Becky exemplifies what it means to be an NRHA Professional through her tenacity, morals, philanthropic heart, and the way she has continuously poured into every aspect of the reining industry for so many years. She has spent her life working to promote and grow the sport of reining through world-wide and local affiliate efforts, as well as serving on the NRHA Board and multiple committees.

"We all wish the Professional of the Year awards existed when she was actively training and showing horses because she would have won it five years in a row," Flaherty said. "Now that the professionals have come up with this award program, we want to be sure it pays homage to her, and this felt like the perfect way to do it."

2020 SADDLES FOR WCRHA YEAR END AWARDS

In addition to the regular WCRHA year end class awards of buckles to Champion and Reserve Champion, jackets to the top 5 and other awards to 3rd, 4th and 5th places, there will also be a SADDLE awarded at the banquet to the following high point riders;

OPEN RIDER – Points awarded on all horses shown in any NRHA OPEN ancillary class (Open, Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Prime Time Open, Rookie Professional, Novice Horse Open Levels 1, 2 & 3 and Snaffle Bit/Hackamore classes only).

NON PRO RIDER – Points awarded on all horses shown (NRHA non pro ownership requirements apply) in any NRHA NON PRO ancillary class (Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro, Limited Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro, Masters Non Pro and Novice Horse Non Pro Levels 1, 2 & 3 classes only).

ROOKIE 2 RIDER - Points awarded on all horses shown in NRHA Rookie 2 classes only.

Riders can accumulate points on more than one horse. Non Pro riders will not accumulate points from showing in open or rookie classes. Aged event classes do not count for points. Points accumulate to the rider, not the horse.

The owner must nominate their horse(s) as they currently do for the regular year end awards before any points are counted and all owners and riders of the horse must be current members in good standing of WCRHA before any points are counted. There will be no points awarded retroactively.

The ONLY shows that will count for points towards the SADDLES are;

WCRHA Affiliate #1 WCRHA Affiliate #2 WCRHA Affiliate #3 WCRHA Affiliate #4 WCRHA Year End Show

The points will be counted as they are for the regular year end awards.

Ties will be broken by money earned.

There is no minimum number of shows that must be attended to qualify for the saddle.


Each year the winner will be awarded:





Rolling Low with the Northwest Affiliate Regional Championships

The Low Roller Reining Classic (LRRC) was held Sunday, October 6 through Saturday, October 12 at the Ford Idaho Horse Park in Nampa, Idaho. The days were a bit nippy for the Californians, but, for the most part, the rain clouds stayed away and the days were beautifully clear. The show has been very popular the last several years, but no one anticipated the large number of horses that participated this year! More stalls had to be brought in to accommodate the 100 extra horses, and, with a 40 percent increase in entries, some classes went past midnight and into the next day!

The LRRC was also the venue for the Northwest Affiliate Regional Championships. Many West Coast Reining members set their goal each year to qualify for the Championship Affiliate classes held annually in November/December at the NRHA Futurity in Okla-

homa City. In order to qualify, they must place in the Top Ten of their class at the Northwest Regional Affiliate Championships (ARC). The ARC classes are run concurrently with the regular ancillary classes.

NRHA ramped up the prestige of placing in the ARC classes this year by awarding the winners with Morrison trophies, Montana Silversmith luggage tags, embroidered winter blankets, increased monies, and other prizes through tenth. At the LRRC, seventeen ARC classes were held. Every year at this show, the winners are presented with the chance to win a horse trailer, valued at \$12,000, in a drawing. For the second year in a row, the trailer was won by a WCRHA member! Having won three ARC classes on Mister Smartypants owned by Eileen and Gordon Maxinoski, Gabe Davide's three draws produced the winning token for the trailer! The Maxinoskis were very pleased to haul the three horse Logan Crossfire trailer back to California! Congratulations to all the Top Ten finishers in the ARC classes!


filiate Regional Champion Team honors! Way to go!



Pid you earn money at a WCRHA show?

If you believe you have earned money at a WCRHA show, here are some things to remember:

- 1. The results that are published on the WCRHA website or the WCRHA Facebook page are UNOF-FICIAL until they have been verified by NRHA. Official results from NRHA may change based on eligibility of horse or rider, etc.
- 2. You should expect to receive a check from WCRHA approximately 45 to 60 days AFTER the show is over.
- 3. If you do not receive a check within that time call WCRHA Treasurer Rachel Fingerle as soon as possible.
- 4. If your check from WCRHA is different from what NRHA lists on its website as your earnings call WCRHA Show Secretary Anna-Lise Kozlowski as soon as possible.



How to Tie a Mecate

.... as found in the 1986 publication of Randy Steffen's Horseman's Scrapbook, published by the Western Horseman Magazine. A very practical and easy-to-follow illustration for our reiners who are using hackamores.



Randy Steffen: A friend from Abilene, Tex., asked me if I knew how to tie a mecate (hair rope reins) on a hackamore. Seems as though not very many horsemen in this part of the country are familiar with the California hackamore, and since that may be true of many parts of the country, these drawings show how to make the mecate reins and lead rope the California way. This is the way Ed Connell, author of Hackamore Reinsman, taught me. To tie it you'll need hair rope (other flexible rope about 5/8-inch in diameter will do if you don't have a hair or mohair rope) about 22 to 24 feet long, with a round Turk's head and tassel in one end.

Follow these drawings step by step, adjusting your reins for proper length when you hit step 3, and you'll wind up with a workable set of reins, and lead rope combined. You can coil the lead rope and tie it on the near fork of your saddle where it'll be out of the way until you want to use it. Make as many wraps around the lower part of the hackamore bosal as you need to make it fit right, but don't make it too tight. The first principle of the hackamore is to afford relief from pressure when the reins are slacked off, so you'll want your bosal loose enough to drop away from the jaw when you slack your reins.

Pop into the New Year with Richard Dias' BBQ Jalapeno Poppersl. Richard and his lovely wife Vicki, a WCRHA Board member, have shared their yummy food with us on numerous occasions, much to the delight of everyone!

Richard Dias' BBQ Jalapeño Poppers

INGREDIENTS

8 Jalapeños (makes 16 poppers)

2 packages 8-oz. Philadelphia cream cheese

1 pound regular sliced bacon (if you use thick slices, it takes much longer to cook)

Your favorite BBQ sauce

DIRECTIONS

You can make these on the BBQ or in the oven.

Take a baking sheet and line it with foil.

Wash and cut the Jalapeños in half lengthwise, and clean all the seeds out of the peppers.

Set to the side.

With a teaspoon, scoop a spoonful of cream cheese and fill each jalapeño.

Then, take a strip of bacon, and starting at the large end of the jalapeño, wrap the bacon around the jalapeño, stretching the bacon slightly while wrapping so it covers the entire pepper.

Arrange the jalapeños on the cookie sheet, cream cheese side up and place on the barbecue at 375-degrees. It should take about 20 to 30 minutes. (Do not turn the jalapeños.)

When the bacon is cooked crisp, brush each one with your favorite BBQ sauce.
