Logan Lindberg NAAC Rookie of the Year Co-Champion



Seventeen-year-old Logan Lindberg had great success with his equine partner, Custom Banjo, at the North American Ancillary Championship (NAAC) show held at the 2020 NRHA Futurity. The pair laid down a stellar run of 218 to tie fellow reiner Allison Thorson for the championship honors of the coveted title of Rookie

of the Year. Custom Banjo is owned by Logan's mother, Megan. He is a 12-year old gelding with more than \$102,000 in NRHA Life Time Earnings. A 2008 bay gelding, he is sired by Banjo Whiz and out of Custom Bobbie. Logan also shared the win with Allison in the NAAC Rookie Level 2 as well as the Rookie Level 1 and 2 classes. In addition, Logan placed in the Top Ten out of more than 50 riders in the Youth 14-18 classes!

Logan is a student at Campolinda High School in Moraga and has aspirations to go to Cal Poly when the time comes. But not only is Logan an accomplished showman in the reining pen, he also loves the rodeo scene! He really enjoys roping and loves competing in high school rodeos as a heeler.

Logan comes from a family of reining competitors. Both his older sister, Tessa, and his mother have had great success on their reiners. When asked

Smoke and Ashes Don't Deter Reiners

A blood orange sun and smoky, ash flurries from nearby wildfires welcomed exhibitors driving in to the Murieta Equestrian Center show grounds in Rancho Murieta, California, on August 20. Little did they know that such would be the norm for all the days of the West Coast Reining Horse Association Year End show, held August 20-23. As the NRHA Show Rep Kain Emmons stated, as he pulled up his face mask, "We don't know if people are wearing masks due to COVID-19 restrictions or because of the smoky air!" Either way, exhibitors, trainers, and other folk adhered to current California state restrictions by wearing masks, social distancing, and having their temperatures taken daily at the entrance gate.

A full slate of ancillary classes as well as Futurity and Derby classes, judged by Nick Baar and Reid Fady, gave everyone ample opportunities to show off their talented horses. Gorgeous, Vaquero buckles are presented to class Champions, and beautiful, silver pocket knives are given to the Reserve Champion class winners. However, there were also a few special awards given at this show.

The NRHA Rookie Professional class was recently renamed the NRHA Becky Hanson Rookie Professional class in honor of Becky Hanson, a beloved member of WCRHA and NRHA. Becky was the winner of the NAAC Rookie Professional class at the NRHA Futurity in 2006. Over the years, she coached and trained many reining competitors from the Rookies on up through the Non Pros, but she truly had a heart for the Rookie riders. The class was won by Dave Bunfill, from Plymouth, showing his own Custom Whizett. "Biscuit," as she is affectionately called, is a five-year old mare sired by Conquistador Whiz and out of Custom Crome mare. Dave and his wife just started showing reining about a year ago. He specifically entered this class because of Becky Hanson. Although he never actually met Becky, he knows a lot about her story. He says, "It meant a lot to me to win this class. It is a real honor!" Dave received the Championship class buckle as well as a specially designed Becky Hanson buckle. Congratulations, Dave!

In addition, in remembrance of Becky, the winner of the Prime Time Rookie class was presented with a beautiful, hand tooled Becky Hanson memorial leather photo album made and sponsored by the Ricotti Saddle Company of nearby Clements. Jennifer Fisher riding Midnight Whiskey Run was the happy recipient. Becky was well known for her beautiful photography, and many WCRHA members have more than one of Becky's gorgeous metal prints adorning their homes.

Another special award was the Gary Van Hoosen Perpetual Memorial Green Reiner trophy presented to Cindy Laver,

winner of the WCRHA Green class. Cindy rode Revolutionic to the win. Revolutionic is one of those reining "war horses" that has carried his various riders to many wins over the years. Gary Van Hoosen was a long-time member, trainer and competitor at WCRHA shows. He was a strong supporter of the emerging reiner, and could always be counted on for an encouraging word and smile.

Cassandra Kindle was thrilled to receive The Topsail Cody Memorial Perpetual Trophy. This large trophy is presented each year to the champion of the Limited Non Pro class. Cassandra's name plaque will be added to all the other winners since 2002. Cassandra's ride for this class was Ill Be Smokinum.

As usual, the Open slate of classes started off the show on Thursday. Over five hours of open competition began at seven in the morning. With scores of 73.5, David Hanson and Mike Boyle laid down what were to be the highest scores of the show. They each shared Championship honors in the Open Maturity and the Open class. David rode Lisa Dentoni's Smart Little Dunnit, and Mike showed Betty McHugh's pretty palomino, Chics Dream. In the Intermediate Open and Limited Open classes, Gabe Davide showed Mister Smartypants to the Championships of both classes with a 72 score. "Smarty" is owned by Gordon and Eileen Maxinoski. Liz Rammerstorfer was close behind Gabe in both classes with a 71.5, riding Like Madd, owned by Kelly Staley. Mike Boyle was also the Champion in the Prime Time Open class on Chics Dream as well as the Reserve Champion on Pale Of Gold, owned by Laetitia Loubser, scoring a 70. Dave Bunfill bested a class of 10 riders in the Becky Hanson Rookie Professional class. Dave showed his own Custom Whizett to a score of 70. Jan Humphrey showed her Tivitos Top Starlet to the Reserve Championship with a score of 68.5.

The two NRHA Green Reiner classes followed the Open slate. Champion of the Level 1 class, with a score of 70.5, was Jodie Brixey showing Shez My Whiskey Girl. Reserve Champion was Tiffany Buschhueter on her Dressed Wright, earning a 69.5 for her efforts. In the Level 2 class, Natalie Cook rode for a 70 score which was good enough to earn the Championship over 14 other entries. She was riding Xtra Allthats Voodoo, a new horse for Natalie. Two riders and three horses were close behind Natalie with scores of 69.5. Tiffany Buschhueter with Dressed Wright was Co-Reserve Champion with Taylor Banks, who showed two of her mother's horses, Spooky Whiz and Rickybacinhollywood. Congratulations to all the NRHA Green exhibitors!

Finishing off the first day of the show was a Pick Your Own Pattern class, an opportunity for exhibitors to have one more time to school their horses. Over thirty riders braved the hottest part of the day to get into the pen one more time.

Bright and early at 7 a.m. on Friday, cool, morning temperatures welcomed over 50 exhibitors in the Open slate of the three levels of Novice Horse classes. For the second show in a row, Gabe Davide and his ride, Mister Smartypants, claimed the Championship buckles and trophies of all three levels! They laid down a score of 73 early in the draw, which proved difficult to top. Ollie Galligan was Reserve Champion in Level 1 on Shine Sugar Shine with a 71.5. This horse belongs to Elizabeth Atkins. With a score of 72.5, Martin Padilla won the Reserve honors in Levels 2 and 3. He rode Jennifer Fisher's Midnite Whiskey Run.

Championing six of the Non Pro classes was Cam Essick and her (as Cam says) "plain, bay" gelding Loveya. Leaving their mark in the arena with a 73, Cam emerged victorious in the Non Pro Level 4 and Prime Time Maturity as well as the Non Pro and the Prime Time Non Pro classes. The duo also went on to win the Non Pro and the Prime Time Non Pro Derbies! Loveya is a proven reiner with LTE earnings of over \$130,000. Two reiners shared the Reserve Championship honors in the Level 4 Maturity. Cassandra Kindle showed her Ill Be Smokinum and Betty McHugh showed her Chics Dream to scores of 72. Betty also was Reserve Champion in the Prime Time Maturity. In the Non Pro as well as the Prime Time Non Pro class, Betty shared the Reserve accolades with Cady Shaw who showed Xtra Playful Step. Both ladies were also Co-Champions in the Masters class. Emerging on top of a class of 20 entries in the Intermediate Non Pro class were four riders with their scores of 72s. Cady and Betty tied with Stacy Hamilton showing Whizzen The Dream and with Ruben Cuevas on his Adinn Lil Spook. Cassandra Kindle and her Ill Be Smokinum were winners of the Limited Non Pro class. In addition to a trophy and buckle, Cassandra was presented with The Topsail Cody Perpetual trophy. Co-Reserve in the Limited class was Lauren Hanson, on her dad's Xtra Dream Step, and Laetitia Loubser on Coronas In Hollywood. They were given scores of 71 for their efforts. Way to go, Non Pros!

Later in the afternoon, four able youth reiners each entered the arena to show the judges their best rides in the Youth Maturity. With a score of 138, Taylor Banks took the Championship with her mother's horse AR Oakies Last Stand. Julia Fry, showing her dad's Iz A Whiz, came in Reserve with a 135. Great job of showing to all four young riders!

Concluding the second day of showing, the Non Pro Futurity allowed six riders to show off their three year olds. Bill Coburn reined his My Skill Your Luck to a score of 137.5 to take away the awards and monies given to the Champion of the Level 4. Caitie Moulding was Champion of the Level 1 Futurity riding her PS Ice Queen. She scored a 138. With a score of 134.5, Debi Murnan was Reserve Champion in both levels with her gelding, Mobsters Tommy Gun. He is a half sibling to Debi's great mare, Jacs Red Pine, both out of Shes Flamin Hot. Congratulations to the Non Pro Futurity exhibitors!

The Rookies stole the arena scene early Saturday morning. More than forty rookie hopefuls rode most of the morning trying to impress the judge. Champion and Reserve Champion of Levels 1 and 2 went to Jenevieve Welker on her Spookebility with a score of 70.5 and Mackenzie McDowell on her Rio Killer Gun with a score of 70, respectively. Jennifer Fisher won the Prime Time Rookie on her Midnite Whiskey Run with a score of 68.5. David Oncale was Reserve with 68 on his Walla Great Pine. Cindy Laver and Revolutionic were big winners over 22 other entries in the WCRHA Green class. In addition to the Championship buckle, they were the winners of the Gary Van Hoosen Perpetual trophy. Cindy scored a 69.5 for the win. Co-Champions for the class were Paige Haverland on Whiz Gotta Spook Ya and Cortney Allen on Starlights Lil Belle, each earning 69s.

Next, taking their turns in the pen, were ten youth riders in the WCRHA Youth 18 & Under class. With a 70 score, Parker Temkin came away with the top prize on his Whizzen R Cash Away. Reserve went to Jenevieve Welker on Rios Iron Man, earning a 69.5 from the judge.

In their first and second year of showing reiners, seventeen exhibitors competed for top awards in their WCRHA Green As Grass class. Shelly Young laid down an impressive run, producing a score of 71, which was good enough to win the class. She showed her Chica Dream to the Championship. Reserve awards went to Shining Boon Chick and Ashley Palmer with a 69.5. Congratulations to a fine group of newer reiners!

Nineteen Non Pros were eager to show their reining horses of ages seven and under in the Non Pro Derby. Cam Essick and her Loveya gathered their fifth and sixth Championship buckles of the show by earning a score of 144 in the Level 4 and Prime Time. Ruben Cuevas

and Adinn Lil Spook were given a 143 to take away the Reserve in Level 4. Level 1 was won with a score of 142.5 by Stacy Hamilton and her Whizzen The Dream. Kelly Staley and Like Madd were Reserve Champions in both the Level 1 and Prime Time classes with a 141.

Five entries in the Open Futurity closed out the third day. PS Ice Queen won her second Futurity championship of the show, first with Non Pro Caitie Moulding on Friday, and secondly, with trainer Jason Richards on Saturday. Jason and the talented three-year old scored a 142.5 to win the Level 4 Futurity. Christian Rammerstorfer showed an offspring of his stallion Maddox to the Reserve championship in Level 4 as well as winning the Level 1. The score was a 140 for Mad Dog Maddox.

The last day of the show dawned early again but still a bit smoky and ashy. That didn't deter the Open Derby riders though as they were eager and ready to hit the show pen with their trusty steeds. Running first in the draw was Eric Laporte on Michell Kimball's Sugar Baby. Eric showcased his talent by earning a score of 143.5 which proved too tough to beat by the rest of the field. They took home the Championship of both Level 4 and Level 1. Sugar Baby is by Spooks Gotta Whiz and out of Smart Sugar Rose. Eric says of the four-year old gelding, "He is so laid back and such a dream to show and get ready." Sugar Baby now has a new owner. His new owner, Megan Meyerdick, looks forward to showing him the Green Reiner classes.

There was a three-way tie for the Reserve Championship in Level 4, all with scores of 142. Dave Bunfill showed his own Gunnatrashya Dream to tie with two of Mike Boyle's entries, Foolin Whiz Guns owned by Kellie Meier and Rio Killer Gun owned by Mackenzie McDowell. Dave Bunfill also tied with Maya Stessin for the Reserve Championship in Level 1. Maya showed Smokin Starbuck to the 142 score for owner Kelly Corbett.

Twenty-five younger equestrians had waited anxiously to get their horses in the pen and were excited to show the judge what they were capable of. Fourth in the draw of the 13 & Under was Steven Allen, Jr., who rode his dad's horse, Crome Topsail, to a score of 68 to win the Championship buckle. Gianna Nelson and Montana Berlin were close behind with their scores of 67 to share the Reserve Championship. Gianna showed Wimpys Lil Commander and Montana rode West Coast Hick. Logan Lindberg and Lauren Hanson were Champion and Reserve Champion respectively in the Youth 14-18 and Unrestricted Youth classes. Logan guided his mom's horse,

With a score of 69.5, Reed Hurley emerged the Champion of the Youth Rookie class on his Red Knight Boonlight. Jenevieve Welker took the Reserve on her Spookebilly with 69. Five riders of the youngest

set entered the Short Stirrup class. Revolutionic, owned by Cindy Laver, took his young rider, Isabella Hall, to a whopping score of 72.5 to win the Championship awards! The Reserve went to Kaydee Brixey on Tangy Chex with another impressive score of 71.5. Congratulations to all the Youth riders! You all will be a force to be reckoned with in years to come!

Three little Lead Liners next entered the ring. Tony Omlan rode Out Back Ebony, Will Brixley was on Tangy Chex, and Zoey Poulter showed Gunning For a Shiner, all to healthy scores of 75 from the judge! What a great group of aspiring little equestrians and their handlers!

Noon-time found the Novice Horse Non Pro riders ready to take the stage. Claiming the buckle in the Level 1 class was Kelly Staley on her gelding Like Madd with a score of 70.5. Reserve went to Marni Lopez on Rowdy-whizrowdydoes with 69.5. Level 2 honors were shared between Tiffany Bauer on her sorrel gelding The Poker Face and Kathleen Cook on her bay Chics Double Magnum, with their scores of 71.5. Congratulations, Ladies!

Last, but certainly not least, were nineteen entries braving the warm temperatures of the final afternoon in the Snaffle Bit/Hackamore 5 & Under class. With a 71.5, Chuy Chavez took home the buckle for Jennifer Lemere as he showed her Whizpur My Name. Martin Padilla tied with himself for the Reserve Championship on Sophia Fisher's Dunit In My Jersey and Tobyann Faingold's Nickis Special Nite with scores of 71.

A large turnout with full classes indicated that Northern California and Nevada reiners were looking forward to getting their horses in the show pen, no matter what the weather conditions. 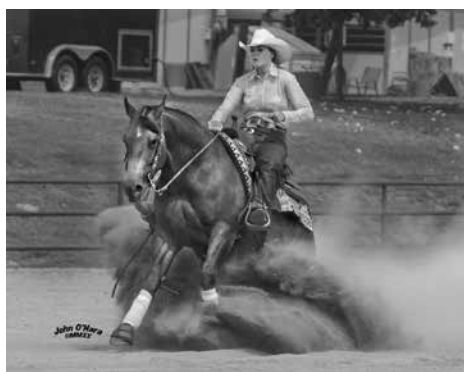

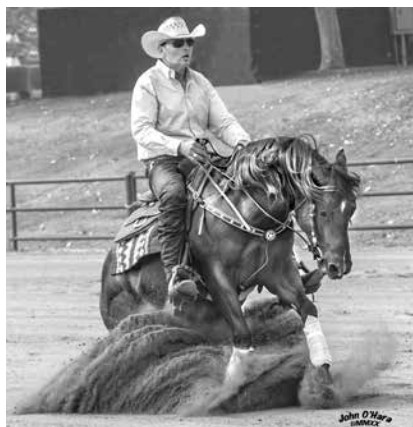

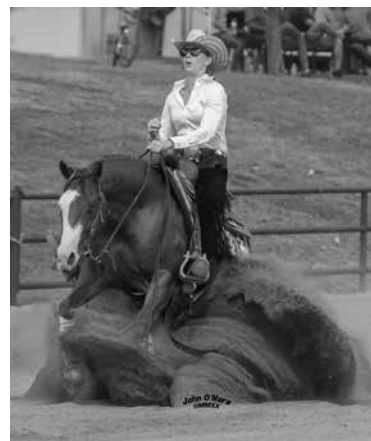

WCRHA Members Rocked It at High Roller Reining Classic



West Coast trainers were Rockin' and a Rollin' in the Open classes on the first day of the High Roller Reining Classic held at the South Point Equestrian Center in Las Vegas on September 11-19. Over one hundred runs kept the Priefert Arena busy well into the evening on Friday, the first day of the show. Out of the five Open classes running concurrently on Friday, four championships or co-championships were won by WCRHA members. For the second year in a row, David Hanson rode Lisa Dentoni's Smart Little Dunit to the championship of the Open L4 class. His admirable score of 73.5 bested the 39 others in the class. Co-Reserve Champion in the Open L4, with a 72.5, was Whizkey Midnite Run, piloted by Martin Padilla and owned by Jennifer Fisher. Jason Richards won the Championship buckle in the Intermediate Open. He rode Xtra Jacked Voodoo owned by Donita Mullins to the win with a 73.

For the third year in a row, Mister Smartypants was Co-Champion in the Limited Open, three years ago with previous trainer Ashley Wilson-Hammer and the last two years with trainer Gabe Davide. Gabe and "Smarty" were also Co-Reserve Champions in the Intermediate Open, Novice Horse Open L1, and Novice Horse Open L2 as well as fifth in the Open L4 with a score of 72.

Capturing the championship prizes in the Novice Horse Open L2 was Martin Padilla on Whizkey Midnite Run. It took a 72.5 to win the buckle for owner Jennifer Fisher. David Hanson shared the Co-Reserve Champion-

ship with three others in the same class with his own Xtra Dream Step with a 72.

Over in the other arena, the WCRHA Non Pros were also laying down impressive runs. 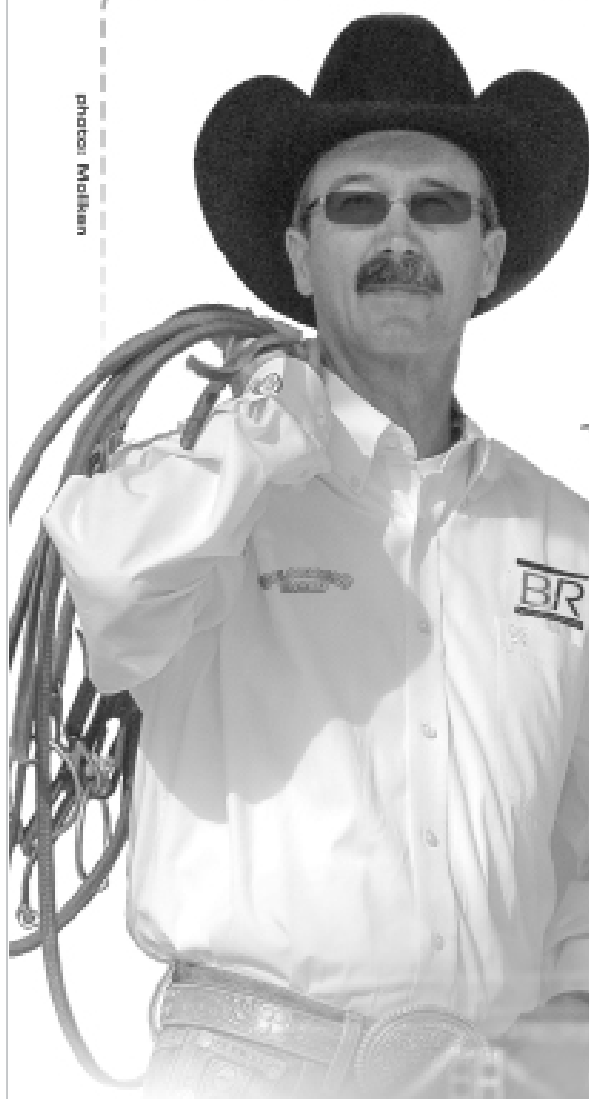
