#### David Hanson 2020 NRHA Professional Horseman of the Year

Every year, the National Reining Horse Association chooses a Professional Horseman of the Year. The NRHA Affiliate of the West Coast Reining Horse Association is honored to have one of their own selected—David Hanson of Hanson Performance Horses. Many challenges in 2020, including the death of his beloved wife Becky, were met with grace and dignity as David set aside his own hardships and focused on making sure that his clients and all WCRHA members could carry on with a successful show season.

David grew up in a horse showing family. He has a sister and a brother who are also in the horse training and showing business.

David and Becky embarked on their equine business with spending five years training horses in Italy and showing them across Europe. When they returned to the U.S. in 2000, the couple settled in Clements, California, where they built a thriving non-pro and youth program, on top of training numerous major event finalists and top finishers.

David's two children have grown up in the WCRHA family, attending every show as youngsters and, eventually, competing with the best of the best. Caden is 19 years old now, and is a Sophomore at Cal Poly, majoring in Agricultural Systems Management. Lauren is 18 years old and a Senior in high school. She will be attending Texas A&M in the fall with a major in Agribusiness.

Caden says of his dad, "Watching my dad as I have grown up has really shown me what it means to be a great horseman and, beyond that, a great person. With all of his other obligations in recent years, he has never let the quality of his training program fall. He always works hard to make sure everything at the barn is prepared, all the horses are well taken care of, and that he provides clients with all the training and preparation they need to do well at the show. 



Elizabeth Rammerstorfer was that rider in 2020. Elizabeth is quick to thank the owners and their horses that have contributed to that awesome achievement, Kelly Staley and Like Madd (by Maddox), Cady Shaw and Xtra Playful Step (by Wimpy's Little Step), Lauren Hanson and Xtra Dream Step (by Magnum Chic Dream), Curt and Cindy Engen and Shezintheblack (by Maddox).

Elizabeth grew up in Carrollton, TX, riding at a small boarding barn as a young girl and went to college at Texas A&M University majoring in Animal Science. Upon graduation Liz went to work for NRHA-million dollar rider Craig Johnson and then Todd Crawford in California for three years. In 1995 she moved back to Texas to begin graduate school at A&M where she met her husband Christian. Upon graduation from graduate school where Elizabeth earned her Masters degree in Equine Exercise Science and Christian earned a Ph.D. degree in Equine Nutrition, the couple moved to Corvallis, OR, where they were heading up the Oregon State University Equine Sciences and Colt Training Program for 7 years. Following a 3 year tenure of training and showing reiners and coaching non pros at Gail Klapper's 6K Ranch in Elbert, Colorado, Elizabeth and Christian settled in Northern California to train and promote reining horses for open and non pro competition in 2010.



The 2020 show season had successes, challenges, and bittersweet moments for the team of Xtra Playful Step a.k.a. Dolly (Wimpy Little Step x Play For Chic) and her riders Elizabeth Rammerstorfer and Cady Shaw on their way to winning the WCRHA Horse of the Year. Dolly was purchased at the 2018 NRHA Futurity after she made the open semi-finals, but once she settled in California it was clear that it would take some time for her to reach her full potential as a reliable non-pro horse for her rider who has some physical limitations. Her sweet and willing personality allowed her to adjust to a new training program with the Rammerstorfers at the end of 2019 with the goal at the beginning of 2020 to step up and add additional non pro and open earnings to her record for her future career as a broodmare.

Dolly's improvement was nothing short of amazing under the guidance of Liz which was evident at the very first show in Corning. She continued to improve for the entire show season garnering WCRHA year-end championships in the Limited Open, Intermediate Non Pro, Prime Time and Masters and a reserve Non-Pro championship. Dolly also placed well with Liz in the open Derby at the Mother's Day Slide in Arizona and helped Cady reach over \$100,000.00 in NRHA earnings; most of which earned in ancillary classes starting with the very first WCRHA show in 1983. Between the interrupted and unpredictable 2020 show season, Dolly spent a majority of her time loping around a pistachio orchard at her home in Madera.

Given all of the uncertainties in 2020, winning Horse of the Year was especially rewarding for Cady to be able to end her 37 years as a WCRHA member on such a high note as she and her husband Phil Sancken moved to Oklahoma in October. Both will miss the fun times they have had with their many WCRHA friends. Liz also recently relocated to Texas, so this successful team will not be able to continue their partnership in 2021. However, Dolly's agreeable nature has continued in 2021 as she tied to win the Level 1 Non Pro Derby at the Winter Slide in Ardmore, Oklahoma under the guidance of her new trainer Matt Flarida. Cady is especially thankful for the efforts of the WCRHA board and volunteers over the years to build such an outstanding affiliate from such a humble beginning and for a year-end awards program which has no parallel.

# High Point Non Pro Rider of 2020

Derek started riding horses while in his forties and began helping his wife Kelli show her horse in local open shows. Soon he bought his own horse, taught himself how to ride and show, and was successful in western pleasure and trail classes. A friend owned a reining horse and Derek wanted to see what reining was all about. Derek rode his friend's reining horse and thought going fast in reining circles was more fun than going slow in pleasure circles and was hooked.

Derek bought Thischicsamistress aka Mistress as a 2 year old and after she was shown at the futurity and derbies brought her home to show her himself. Mistress at age 13 now has over \$20,000 in earnings and has won multiple awards in reining and ranch riding and achieved her AQHA Register of Merit. This is the first saddle Mistress has won! Derek keeps Mistress at home and does all the work on her himself. He loves showing her and is proud of her accomplishments.

Derek rode Ima Shiny Mister aka Dually to wins in the Prime Time and Masters Non Pro classes at Affiliate #1 last year and then Covid struck. The remaining shows he had to rely on his trainer Thad Carr to keep Dually ready to show so Derek could "catch ride" him at the shows with no other practice time.

Derek said, "Showing two different horses at a show in the same classes is stressful. My horses show differently and one I know very well and the other I don't. I depend on my wife to keep everything organized so I can just concentrate on showing. Winning this saddle was a team effort and Thank you to WCRHA for sponsoring it!"

#### 2021 SADDLES FOR WCRHA YEAR END AWARDS

In addition to the regular WCRHA year end class awards of buckles to Champion and Reserve Champion, jackets to the top 5 and other awards to 3rd, 4th and 5th places, there will also be a SADDLE awarded at the banquet to the following high point riders;

OPEN RIDER – Points awarded on all horses shown in any NRHA OPEN ancillary class (Open, Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Prime Time Open, Rookie Professional, Novice Horse Open Levels 1, 2 & 3 and Snaffle Bit/Hackamore classes only).

NON PRO RIDER – Points awarded on all horses shown (NRHA non pro ownership requirements apply) in any NRHA NON PRO ancillary class (Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro, Limited Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro, Masters Non Pro and Novice Horse Non Pro Levels 1, 2 & 3 classes only).

ROOKIE 2 RIDER – Points awarded on all horses shown in NRHA Rookie 2 classes only.

\*\*Riders can accumulate points on more than one horse. Non Pro riders will not accumulate points from showing in open or rookie classes. Aged event classes do not count for points. Points accumulate to the rider, not the horse.\*\*

The owner must nominate their horse(s) as they currently do for the regular year end awards before any points are counted and all owners and riders of the horse must be current members in good standing of WCRHA before any points are counted. There will be no points awarded retroactively.

The ONLY shows that will count for points towards the SADDLES are:

WCRHA Affiliate #1

WCRHA Affiliate #2

WCRHA Affiliate #3

WCRHA Affiliate #4

WCRHA Year End Show

The points will be counted as they are for the regular year end awards. Ties will be broken by money earned. There is no minimum number of shows that must be attended to qualify for the saddle.

#### 2021 YOUTH SADDLES FOR WCRHA YEAR END AWARDS

In addition to the regular WCRHA year end class awards of buckles to Champion and Reserve Champion, jackets to the top 5 and other awards to 3rd, 4th and 5th places, there will also be a SADDLE awarded in the following youth classes as a year end award at the banquet;

YOUTH 13 & UNDER (One horse and one rider combination)

YOUTH 14-18 (One horse and one rider combination)

The owner must nominate their horse as they currently do for the regular year end awards before any points are counted and all owners and riders of the horse must be current members in good standing of WCRHA before any points are counted. There will be no points awarded retroactively.

The ONLY shows that will count for points towards the SADDLES are:

WCRHA Affiliate #1

WCRHA Affiliate #2

WCRHA Affiliate #3

WCRHA Affiliate #4

WCRHA Year End Show

The points will be counted as they are for the regular year end awards. Ties will be broken by the youth with the most 1st place finishes, then 2nd place finishes, etc.

There is no minimum number of shows that must be attended to qualify for the saddle.

It is possible that the same person who wins the saddle in a class does not also win the Champion Buckle in the class.

The rules for the youth saddles are different than those for the Open, Non Pro and Rookie 2 year end saddles.

The regular year end awards will be calculated as per usual with other approved shows counting for points and a minimum of 4 shows must be attended and 3 shows for short stirrup. See wcrha.com under "points, shows and year end awards" for details.

#### Cooperative Weather Welcomes WCRHA Reiners

Beautiful weather greeted huge classes of West Coast Reining Horse Association reiners as they showed up with their highly tuned reining horses for the annual NRHA approved affiliate reining show held at the Rolling Hills Equestrian Center in Corning, California, on March 5-7. The schooling day, held the day before actual classes began, ran for nearly 15 hours! In addition to full slates of reining classes, AQHA reining classes as well as Ranch Riding classes were offered. Everyone appreciated the hospitality and welcoming accommodations provided by Arena Events Manager, Terry Skevington, and the Rolling Hills Casino.

Christian Rammerstorfer, an NRHA Professional and NRHA judge, had a particularly good showing with his own mare, Reinsincalifornia. Consistent scores of 72 and 72.5 earned the duo Championships and Reserve Championships in the seven classes that they entered. "Stevie," as she is affectionately called, was bred and raised by Christian and is a full sister to Maddox, Christian's beloved stallion. (Stevie's dam raised 13 foals for Christian with four of them being full siblings.) Nine-year old Stevie already has two foals to her credit and will raise another this year. Christian says she is his "favorite mare of all time." She has "very powerful, naturally free stops which have contributed to her maturity into a solid show horse." Job well done, Reinsincalifornia and Christian!

Starting the show on the first day were the Open classes. Mike Boyle, riding Betty McHugh's Chics Dream, laid down a blistering run of 73.5 to run away with the Championship honors in the Open class. The duo also won the AQHA Open Reining. The Reserve award in the Open went to Christian Rammerstofer with his Reinsincalifornia with a score of 72.5. Chrisitian's score also went on to place him as Champion of the Intermediate Open and the Limited Open, tie for Champion in the Prime Time Open, and the Reserve Champion in the AQHA Open Reining. Christian also was the Reserve Champion in the Limited Open with Kelly Staley's Like Madd with a 71.5. In the Intermediate Open, David Hanson was Reserve Champion on Anne Driscoll's Xtra Needs A Drink with a score of 71.5. Jason Richards and Ps Ice Queen, owned by Caitie Moulding, were Reserve Champions in the Prime Time Open with 72.5. Nickis Special Nite, shown by Ivan Flores and owned Tobyann Faingold, were the Champions with a 69.5 in the Rookie Professional class with Jan Humphrey on her Hot Electric Spark coming in Reserve with a 69. Congratulations to all the riders and owners of these talented Open level reining horses!

Over 60 hopeful equestrians competed for prizes in the Rookie and WCRHA Green classes. Sweeping the Championships of all three Rookie divisions, with a 72 score, was Stephanie Marcozzi riding her own Alpha Brave Hard! He is a six-year old gelding sired by Gunners Special Nite and out of Miss Brim Peppy. Stephanie has owned her pretty sorrel gelding for a little over a year and credits the Boyle Ranch trainers for all their help in prepping for the 2021 show season. Rooster Who, under the guidance of reiner Brooke Banks, scored a 71 to win the Reserve Championship in Rookie I and Rickybacinhollywood, ridden by Brooke's sister Taylor, was Reserve in Rookie II with a 71.5. Jennifer Fisher was Reserve in the Prime Time Rookie class on her Midnite Whizkey Run with a 71.5. Nice showing by our Rookie riders! The WCRHA Green Reiner class was won by Nikki Garecht and The Oyarzun Family's Nickle Slots with a score of 70.5. Reserve awards were split between Shelley Young riding Chica Dream and Jason Brixey on Gray Goose Juice with scores of 69.5. First place in the AQHA Amateur Level 1 class was won by Cindy Laver on her Revolutionic with a score of 70.5. Second went to Gunna Get Tipsy, ridden and owned by Isabelle Ord with a score of 68.5.

Closing up the first day of showing were the Ranch Riding classes, an offering of something a little different for the reining community. Coming out on top of the AQHA Open Ranch Riding class was Alpha Gun Shiner owned and shown by Stephanie Boyes. Second was Im Magnificent, shown by Christian Rammerstrofer and owned by Scott Johnson. Codes Dun Express, ridden and owned by Lianne Talbot, won the AQHA Amateur Ranch Riding with Stylish Inferno, shown and ridden by Amanda Brewer, coming in second. The WCRHA Ranch Riding All Ages proved competitive with Paul Magistri winning the class on Shelda Magistri's Gay Bar Chic. Second was Heidi Nash on her Driveslikea Mercedes.

Nearly 40 reiners started day two, eager to show the

judge their best rides in the NRHA Green Reiner classes! Champion of the Green Reiner Levels 1 and 2 was Nicol Shroyer, showing her Hot Spook to a score of 71. Stephanie Marcozzi and her Alpha Brave Hard were close behind to claim the Reserve title with a 70.5.







No year end awards are given in the following classes: Novice Horse Open Level 3, Novice Horse Non Pro Level 3, Unrestricted Youth, WCRHA Youth Reining, NRHA Green Reiner Levels 1 & 2, Ranch Riding or AQHA classes.

To be eligible for WCRHA year end awards you, must meet the following criteria:

- The horse's owners and riders must be current members in good standing of WCRHA before any
  year end points can be earned at any show.
- You must pay a nomination fee of \$25 per horse to qualify for year end awards. This fee must be
  paid and the nomination form filled out before any points are counted towards year end awards.
  The form is available on the WCRHA website on the membership form and also in the show office.
- There will be no year end points awarded retroactively.
- The horse and rider must compete in a minimum of four (4) shows per class (3 shows for short stirrup). These shows are listed on the WCRHA website.

There are two different amounts of year end points that can be earned depending upon which shows you attend.

- A maximum of 15 points will be awarded ONLY at the four (4) WCRHA Affiliate shows and the WCRHA Year End Show. This only applies when there are 15 or more entries actually shown in a class. (Example: If there are 15 entries in the class, First Place = 15 points, Second Place = 14 points, etc. If there are 25 entries in the class, First Place = 15 points, Second Place = 14 points, etc. If there are 7 entries in the class, First Place = 7 points, Second Place = 6 points, etc.) No points are awarded for a 0 score.
- A maximum of 5 points will be awarded each day of the show at WCRHA approved shows—Spring Gold-n-Grand and Summer Gold-n-Grand. This only applies if there are 5 or more entries actually shown in a class. Each individual day you show will count as a show attended for year end totals. The WCRHA approved shows are not put on or managed by WCRHA but we give our approval to these shows to give our members more opportunities to show their horses and accumulate year end points. These shows report their results to WCRHA and your points earned there will be included in our totals for the year end points and awards.

The amount of money won each time will count towards total money won. The money earned at the shows is used to break any ties in year end points.

The WCRHA year end points are listed on the WCRHA website and are updated regularly. If you have any questions whatsoever about the points or your eligibility, please call Rachel Fingerle as soon as possible at 916-698-7224.




