

Dates: Vendor Set-Up will begin Sunday July 13^{th,} at 7:00 am. All vendors must be in place by Noon Monday July 14th. Specific set-up times will be required by management to facilitate entry, unloading, and exiting of vehicles. Tear down may begin no earlier than 5:00pm, Sunday July 20th (no Major moving until after the last horse has exit the pen after completion of pattern and must completed moving out by 9:00 am Monday July 21st.

Inside Space: Vary 13' x 13'-6 sections around the concourse of the arena, in climate-controlled, Equestrian Complex.

Contact Kelley in need particular accommodations. Vendors are responsible for bringing all setup equipment and manpower. Reno-Livestock facility & WCRHA does not provide any set up equipment accept if trailer is under 14 ft.

Please contact Mike at (775)690-1135 for further accommodations. The Equestrian Complex is open from 8am-6pm.

Indoor Vendor space cost is \$250.

Outside Space: Outdoor Vendors will set up between the arena and practice arena. NO TRAILERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARK IN FRONT OF BARN 1. Reno Livestock is limited with electrical outlets so spaces fill up fast. Outdoor space cost is \$200

Insurance: All vendors must provide proof of insurance prior to coming onto the grounds. Insurance is required in the amount of \$100,000 per occurrence and \$1 million general aggregate. The following must be named as additional insured on the policy: West Coast Reining Horse Association

Licensing: All vendors will be required to provide a License Number from state they are from. For questions, please contact the State Department of Revenue for the designated state you are from. The vendor is responsible for complying with the applicable local, state, or federal laws, and regulations, or fees. Tax forms for the State of Reno will need to be attached to application form.
