#### **Show and Arena Conditions**

Motion: Kain Emmons Seconded: Barbi Boyle Passed by majority

On Thursday May 29 the Show Subcommittee had a zoom call with Show management it was determined an additional show pen would be required. To facilitate this, the cost will be approximately \$10k for sand and trucking. The show will recoup this via a facility fee on entries. Show management insisted this is necessary for a fun, safe, and quality experience and the show may be difficult if not impossible without this and the show subcommittee unanimously agreed. As this is a financial matter we feel the entire board should be involved in approving this. We ask that everyone respond with there vote on the matter. If there is an

objection we can have a zoom call to discuss or you're welcome to contact our show manager, Doug Hammack, directly at 303-601-0623 with questions. We understand this is not how we normally handle these matters or votes, but we are on expedited time table to accomplish this.

Grounds Fee to be \$35 at Star Spangled Slide

Additional \$1,800 being paid to the facility for rental use of loader for the groundwork by Thad. Fuel not included on 30 gallon tank which Thad will need to refill to work, cost not to approx. \$1,200. This item is separate from the ground bill and maintenance from Thad.
