



Pro/Am Rules

This high-energy evening is to help West Coast Reining Youth Association to provide educational funding, scholarships, and provide for the youth in the organization. Attendees are encouraged come out to the Calcutta on Friday night to bid on their favorite team! We encourage you to come back on Saturday night to cheer on your favorite team as they ride to a song of their choosing.

How It Works

Teams of Two: One NRHA Professional + one NRHA Non Pro or Youth rider per team (yes you can have teams of non-pros/youth only too). Any NRHA-licensed horse can be shown. Each rider on the teams will compete on the same horse.

Split Pattern Format/Scoring: Riders compete on the horses, each performing half of NRHA Pattern 10. The Pro rides maneuvers 1–4, then exits the arena. The Non Pro/Youth enters and completes maneuvers 5–8 (Or Visa-Versa). Combined scores determine team placings. Further explanation is provided here:

- **Maneuver 1-4:** The NRHA Professional/Non Pro or Youth will complete Maneuver 1-4, ending with the left lead change. After the lead change, the rider will no longer be judged and will come down to a stop to change riders in the arena to watch their teammate perform the remaining maneuvers.
- **Maneuver 5-8:** The NRHA Non Pro or Youth/The NRHA Professional will enter the arena to be judged on the remaining maneuvers. They will begin on the left lead and continue to the center of the arena to begin Maneuver 5, without stopping or breaking gait. The teammate will then perform maneuver 5-8, ending with final stop and hesitate.
- **Entry Fee:** \$75 per team
- **Entry Cap:** 15 teams (first-come, first-served)
- **Awards**

What is a Calcutta?

Calcutta is where we auction off teams. The auctioneer will have the teams come up and will begin the bidding. Highest bidder of the team wins the team.

How the money breaks down you ask?

From all the bidding it goes into a Pot. 50% of the pot goes directly to the WCRHyA. The other 50% is dispersed between the Champion team & Champion team's highest bidder AND the Reserve Champion team & Reserve Champion's team highest bidder.

50% goes to WCRHyA

15% goes to Champion Team

15% goes to Champion Team's highest bidder

10% goes to Reserve Team

10% goes to Reserve Team's highest bidder
