



Ride a Buck Rules

This class is a fundraiser for the West Coast Reining Horse Youth Association, to challenge the individual's balance and rhythm with their horse. The proceeds from this class provides meals for the youth at youth meetings, allows WCRHyA to provide awards for their fundraiser classes, and also allows to learn how to organize events.

How It Works

Participants will ride their horse bareback. If the individual competing is under the age of 18 we require a helmet to be worn before entering the pen for the rider's safety. The rider will sit on a \$1, \$5, \$10, or \$20 the denomination is at the rider's digression but must be at the minimum of \$1. A MINIMUM OF 1 RIDER PER HORSE.

The rider will place the dollar under their seat bones and will go on the rail to perform the correct gaits announced by announcer. Once the rider loses the dollar in which they are sitting on they will be excused to walk their horse into the middle of the arena until there is only 1 rider left on the rail.

The rider that is the "last man standing" will collect all the dollars that the other participates have lost from riding. We encourage you to "risk it for the biscuit" when choosing the amount of dollar bill you sit on to participate in this class. Awards will be given for Champion & Reserve Champion for this class (along with the Champion collecting the dollars from the participates that lost them during the class).

- Entry Fee: \$25 to enter the class.

Please bring your own helmet if you are under the age of 18. There will be spotters in the middle of the arena for the safety of the rider and the dollar bill that has been dropped.

Awards:

Champion Rider- Wins a Custom Stall bag and all of the lost dollars in the pen from the riders.
